

### Our new meeting room

Regular monthly meetings are held at the Grange Park Sports Club, Old Boston Road, Wetherby, LS22 5NB on second Tuesday each month at 8.00 pm, presentations at 8.30.

#### **Change of meeting location**

After 12 happy years at the Bridge Hotel, we had to consider an alternative place to meet. The new owners of the Bridge have told us that they need to charge us £100 per meeting unless a minimum of 15 members dine at the carvery before the meeting. The working group decided that this was unacceptable pressure on members, most of whom indicated in the survey devised and analysed by Colin, that they were not interested in dining.

By giving us their excellent facilities without charge, Philip Roberts, the former owner and his staff, have enabled us to hold membership fees to a much lower level than the majority of other classic car clubs.

Joan has looked at a number of possible locations, including pubs, social clubs etc. The Grange Park Sports Club was agreed by a working group meeting, and by a unanimous vote amongst members present at the August club meeting as the best option. This location will charge us £40 per meeting, amongst the lower costs we looked at. After extensive discussion at the same club night, it was proposed and accepted that membership fees will be increased to £30 per membership from the next AGM. As at present, each membership will include spouses/partners and immediate family members. The Grange Park Sports Club does not operate a restaurant, so no pressure to eat, but the drinks from the bar are £1 or more cheaper than the Bridge, so plenty of stimulation for lively chat.

The Grange Park Sports club has a lounge which can be separated from the main bar by a substantial partition which gives us privacy, it has a built in projector and screen for our speakers and all the facilities we need for regular meetings, Food service is by an outside caterer, and Margaret, Gillian

and their helpers will check on this and decide

suitable for our Xmas and February "Parties". There is plenty of parking to accommodate our concours night, and we can use the car park as a starting point for runs giving us easier access to routes to the south and west.

All access is on the level, so easier for wheelchairs.

#### **Grange Park Location**



Wetherby Grange is located just off the A168 link road from the main Wetherby roundabout by the Mercure hotel towards the A1. Leaving Wetherby, Grange Park is clearly signposted, on the left, about 200 yards from the roundabout. Coming North from the A1 on the A168, there is a gap in the central reservation to turn right into Grange Park. Take care – several unmarked fierce road humps close to the Club itself!!
