Bob and I are organising a trip to Teesdale for club members and friends. The dates for our 3 night stay are April 21.22.23.

The venue is the Teesdale Hotel on the B6277 on the Market Place in Middleton-in-Teesdale on the border of the North Pennines Website www.teesdalehotel.co.uk

Nearby attractions include High Force (England's largest waterfall), Low Force, Cauldron Snout (England's largest cascade), Raby Castle, Barnard Castle, Bowes Castle, Brough Castle, Egglestone Abbey, the Killhope Wheel Lead Mining Centre, and the world famous Bowes Museum.
