If you use any link on this website to send an email or any link information on this website to make a contact telephone call, please be aware that the following Privacy Statement (relating to Members of the Wetherby Classic Car Club) may apply to any data that you communicate.

## 1) PRIVACY POLICY

The UK General Data Protection Act (25th May 2018) states that we have to provide Members with information regarding how we use and manage your personal data.

The only personal data (as defined by the Act) we collect and record is your name, address, email, telephone contact details and sometimes image.

The WCCC Data Controller is the Membership Secretary, who can be contacted using the details available on the Club Website.

The purpose of collecting your data is to manage the affairs of the club. The Legal Basis for collecting your data is our Legitimate Interest – which is to manage the Club.

The recipients of your personal data are the Club's officers i.e. the "Working Group".

If you have given agreement, your personal data can be made available ONLY to current club members.

All personal data is password protected in an encrypted form in the UK. Your data will be kept during your membership and for two years afterwards until the membership is deemed to have lapsed permanently.

You have the right to request access to your data and ask for rectification of any errors.

Withdrawal of permission to share data with other members may be made at any time.

You have the right to require erasure of your personal data at any time.

Full erasure would mean loss of membership as contact details would be lost.

To become a member of the WCCC, you will need to provide the data required on the Club Membership Application Form.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the UK Supervisory Authority.
